### Eabruppy 2022 NMEs hosic food program has provided assistance of Telehealth Program NMF's medical doctors provided healthcare services to 228

Burmese in Moesot including 72 mgles, 117 femgles and 39 children. 15 patients received teleconsultation, while 205 patients were provided with treatment in the home, and 7 patients were referred to Mae Tao Clinic. Since the start, NMF's telehealth program has provided free healthcare services to 1,575 Burmese in Mae Sct, which cover 450 males (27%), 905 females (54%) and 310 children (19%).
